**Policy Reform Agenda for Arizona, 2007-2008**

- Refer to the ballot a meaningful spending limit based on personal income
- Promote property tax reforms:
  - Make the county equalization rate repeal permanent
  - Raise the exemption for business personal property
  - Accelerate the reduction in the business assessment ratio to 20 percent
  - Refer a firm assessed value/levy limitation to the 2008 ballot and contribute to efforts to do the same via initiative
- Promote income tax reforms:
  - Achieve further reductions in personal income tax rates
  - Reduce the job-killing corporate income tax rate
- Open Arizona to the interstate health insurance market
- Promote school choice:
  - Provide tax relief for homeschoolers and a voucher for military kids
  - Get floor votes on a universal voucher program
- Work with coalitions on No Taxpayer Money for Lobbyists, a ballot initiative to prohibit the use of taxpayer dollars for lobbying, and No Taxpayer Money for Politicians, a prohibition on the use of taxpayer dollars for political candidates
- Work with coalitions to establish at least one highway that is privately financed, built, and operated, and one section of high-occupancy/toll (HOT) lane on an existing project
